DECLARATION OF COUNSEL

I, Jonathan Grossman, declare:

1. I am a staff attorney for Sixth District Appellate Program, which has been appointed to represent appellant Mario Salazar. I handled the appeal as a staff case.

2. Good cause exists for the requested authorization for translator fees because:

a. Appellant speaks and is literate in Spanish; he does not speak or read and write in English. He was appointed a Spanish interpreter in the trial court.

b. I do not speak Spanish, nor can I read or write letters in Spanish.

c. Mr. Salazar and I wrote to each other discussing whether he should proceed with his appeal. This required an understanding of his right to appeal, the scope of the appeal, and the issues which could be raised. He wrote to me three letters and I wrote to him two letters which needed to be translated by the Century School of Languages. The total cost was \$451.79.

3. No prior requests for translator fees has been made.
